Guests staying on the three Grand Club floors can access the upscale executive lounge for a full breakfast, evening snacks, beer and wine. Aside from the spa, the 19th floor also houses a fully equipped gym, too. The 18th floor holds several meeting rooms with state-of-the-art technology, while the 20th floor is home to El Castillo, a stately events' room surrounded by crystal walls that will allow up to 300 guests to admire the unforgettable views of the castle.

And with first-class dining options a few blocks away, the Mexico City hotel must keep up with its neighbors. Salammbô, the Grand Fiesta's restaurant, does not disappoint with its fusion of Mediterranean and Mexican cuisine served during breakfast, lunch and dinner.
